Who we want:

MSA seeks a professional with substantial experience as a **Collaboration, learning, and adaptation (CLA) expert based in Ghana** to work as an integral part of a team to design, develop, deliver, and evaluate learning activities in a USAID-funded project that aims to promote trade and investment in agribusiness, exports, and environmentally sustainable business ecosystems in Ghana. The CLA expert will guide the project through an adaptive, **evidence-based approach** to project activities, in which monitoring, and evaluation findings rapidly feed into project learning and decision-making. The position is responsible for **supporting a series of learning and adaptation focused activities**. Critically, the consultant will be responsible for incorporating a variety of methods and innovative approaches to design fit-for-purpose learning activities that engage partners (project staff, private & public sector partners, local research firms, etc.) and promote an effective learning environment across interventions, ensuring that project results meet a high standard for rigor.

MarketShare Associates's role is to strengthen the design and administration of a collaborating, learning, and adapting (CLA) strategy to gather and share evidence on which strategies work to promote trade and investment in agribusiness, promotion of exports, and improving environmentally sustainable business ecosystems in Africa. The first initiative will be to support the project team in Ghana in developing and implementing their CLA strategy and interventions.

The position will be **based in Ghana** and will involve in-country travel to project locations.

Specific responsibilities include:

The following is an indication of the expectations from the role, this is subject modification based on requirements of the program.

- Develop and drive the implementation of a Collaboration, Learning, and Adaptation (CLA) strategy, including a clear set of prioritized learning questions.
- Drive the development of tools, guidelines and resources to support CLA integration within the program.
- Conduct research to answer partner's learning questions, through a mixed methods approach through key informant interviews, focus group discussions, and analysis of project-generated and secondary data.
- Build the processes and culture of learning across the partner's portfolio,
- Design and coordinate high-quality learning interventions such as pause and reflect sessions, multi-stakeholder workshops, learning events, partner learning visits, etc.
- Build the learning capacity of the project team and partners in utilizing CLA principles and practices.
- Provide guidance to project teams to design and adapt interventions based on

evidence, including existing literature, secondary and project-generated data, and lessons learned from within the targeted project or other relevant activities.

- Develop high-quality, user-friendly learning products with strong communication elements that deliver key messages and data designed to influence the target audience.
- Produce high-quality progress and learning reports for the client as required.
- Proactively coordinate any research work to be implemented locally through local research firms to ensure high data quality standards.
- Develop and maintain systems for effective information sharing and communication.

Required qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in international development, development studies, social sciences, implementation science, monitoring and evaluation, or a related field
- Minimum of ten years' work experience in strategic learning, knowledge management, qualitative and/or quantitative research, communications, and/or M&E in a development context
- Strong understanding and practical experience of Collaborating, Learning, and Adapting (CLA) principles and approaches, with experience integrating CLA into project design and implementation
- Excellent qualitative and quantitative skills with a very good grasp of statistical methods and small sample designs, including data analysis. Proficiency in statistical software (such as R, STATA, SPSS) preferred
- Strong ability to design and conduct qualitative research that addresses project learning priorities
- Demonstrated ability to design and facilitate trainings, meetings, and workshops, including learning-oriented events such as pause and reflect sessions
- Experience with private sector development, market systems facilitation and/or other economic development approaches (e.g., economic strengthening, inclusive business)
- A positive, collaborative attitude, and ability to build the capacity of colleagues and partners in monitoring, learning, and adaptation
- Excellent English written and oral communication skills
- Excellent ability to collaborate with and influence colleagues to ensure that monitoring findings are used
